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Where we worked in 2021

Through Joven.lat, the foundation continued to provide vulnerable Latin Americans with opportunities for work, study or entrepreneurship throughout the continent. The construction of protective fences by local workers continued in Patagonia through the Natura program. In Uruguay, deserving students received tool kits to help them start their professional activity (program Emprendedores), while the sewing machines finally arrived in Trinidad, Cuba (program Mujeres).



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Joven.lat Finalization of the collaboration with Daniel Montero. We consider that the main part of the links on the opportunity providers is achieved. The goal

now is to update it permanently, through a semi-automatic process carried out by volunteers. An embryonic project of collaboration with a Brazilian university, through Global Chamber, is in preparation.





Mujeres Due to the near impossibility of traveling to Cuba, we had to put the projects on hold. In particular, we could not start the sewing machines that arrived in Trinidad at the beginning of the year, although the electrical connections were installed there. However, contacts were maintained, and activities were able to resume in 2022.





Natura The program focused on its first project Shoonem.

Shoonem (Patagonia, Argentina).
Continuation of the construction by vulnerable youth, supervised by professionals, of protective fences against pumas and other predators, which like to feed on small ruminants. Christoph is in constant contact with these teams.

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Uruguay: The third Ganydar sponsored golf tournament was organized by Gregor Schmid. It raised enough funds to provide more than 30 graduates of the Colonia del Sacramento workshop school with a set of tools to start their professional life.
