Report of the statutory auditor on the limited statutory examination to the board of the foundation of GANYDAR STIFTUNG 8835 Feusisberg

As statutory auditor, we have examined the financial statements (balance sheet, income statement and notes) of GANYDAR STIFTUNG for the year ended December 31, 2019.

These financial statements are the responsibility of the board of the foundation. Our responsibility is to perform a limited statutory examination on these financial statements. We confirm that we meet the licensing and independence requirements as stipulated by Swiss law. Employees of our firm assisted in the accounting in the reporting year. However, they did not participate in the limited statutory examination.

We conducted our examination in accordance with the Swiss Standard on the Limited Statutory Examination. This standard requires that we plan and perform a limited statutory examination to identify material misstatements in the financial statements. A limited statutory examination consists primarily of inquiries of company personnel and analytical procedures as well as detailed tests of company documents as considered necessary in the circumstances. However, the testing of operational processes and the internal control system, as well as inquiries and further testing procedures to detect fraud or other legal violations, are not within the scope of this examination.

Based on our limited statutory examination, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the financial statements do not comply with Swiss law, the deed of foundation and the bylaws and regulations of the foundation.

We would like to point out that in opposition to the provisions of article 958 paragraph 3 of the Swiss Code of Obligations the financial statements were not submitted to the board of the foundation for approval within six months of the end of the financial year.

Accounting principles

The accounting principles applied in the preparation of these financial statements comply with article 957 et seq. of the Swiss Code of Obligations in connection with article 83a Para. 2 of the Swiss Civil Code.

Deviation from the principle of consistency of presentation and valuation

The useful life of the intangible asset "Platform joven.lat" was adjusted from 5 years to 3 years resulting in CHF 8'080 of additional amortization expenses per year.

Donations

Donations are recognized in the period for which the irrevocable pledge has been made by the donor. Donations-in-kind are recognized as expenses on one hand and donation income on the other hand.

2 Specific Project Funds

The project funds are funded by donations made to specific projects to exclusively serve the financing of the respective project. In the absence of a deviating agreement, a share of 30% of donations made to restricted projects is attributed to cover general and administrative expenses of the foundation.

3 Project execution expenses

Project execution expenses entail costs for identifying projects, evaluating projects and carrying out the necessary due diligence, planning and executing the projects as well as tracking and ensuring that results are achieved.

Current Projects

Project "Joven.lat"

The internet-based platform "Joven.lat" is bundling a big number of job-platforms offering a wide range of employment, educational, and entrepreneurial opportunities to the young generation of Latin America. The platform is promoted through social networks and various radio stations throughout Latin America to reach as many young people as possible.

Project "Tools for Cuba"

From pre-Columbian temples to colonial Baroque churches, Latin America possesses a rich cultural heritage. However, neglect has led to the deterioration and loss of many heritage assets over the last seventy years. What if unemployed youngsters were to learn a craft and restore their local heritage sites?

Our goal is to train 300 vulnerable youngsters in a craft, enabling them to earn a living from day one. Achieve a 70% employment rate after one year of graduating. Participate in the restoration and preservation of at least 10 local heritage sites in La Habana, Trinidad and Cienfuegos.

Project "Tools for LATAM"

The biggest challenge graduates face is not having access to the right tools to work. After extensive preparation, our foundation has launched a new, complementary programme: toolsets for graduates. This initiative gives graduates a basic toolset so that they can work and earn a living from day one after the School programme.

Our goal is to donate 430 toolsets to apprentices in three workshop-schools: Colonia (Uruguay), Puebla (Mexico) and Brazil (João Pessoa). Achieve a 70% employment rate after one year of graduation.

Project "Natura"

The programme combines the pleasant (the joy of participating in the protection of the fantastic Latin American nature) with the useful (helping the vulnerable populations living there). Indeed, protecting nature on the spot creates training and jobs, thus giving perspectives to those that Ganydar supports.

Project "Mujeres tejiendo su futuro"

Four projects have been initiated to support local women in producing profitable and quality professional clothing, to give more autonomy through the work of sewing, to deliver two years of vocational training in the sewing and textile trades, and to develop a center in Switzerland that coordinates all programme activities.
