Report of the statutory auditor on the limited statutory examination to the general meeting of GANYDAR STIFTUNG 8835 Feusisberg

As statutory auditor, we have examined the financial statements (balance sheet, income statement and notes) of GANYDAR STIFTUNG for the year ended December 31, 2022.

These financial statements are the responsibility of the board of the foundation. Our responsibility is to perform a limited statutory examination on these financial statements. We confirm that we meet the licensing and independence requirements as stipulated by Swiss law. Employees of our company assisted in the bookkeeping during the reporting year. These individuals were not involved in the limited statutory examination.

We conducted our examination in accordance with the Swiss Standard on the Limited Statutory Examination. This standard requires that we plan and perform a limited statutory examination to identify material misstatements in the financial statements. A limited statutory examination consists primarily of inquiries of company personnel and analytical procedures as well as detailed tests of company documents as considered necessary in the circumstances. However, the testing of operational processes and the internal control system, as well as inquiries and further testing procedures to detect fraud or other legal violations, are not within the scope of this examination.

Based on our limited statutory examination, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the financial statements do not comply with Swiss law, the deed of foundation and the regulations of the foundation.

# **Accounting principles**

The accounting principles applied in the preparation of these financial statements comply with article 957 et seq. of the Swiss Code of Obligations in connection with article 83a Para. 2 of the Swiss Civil Code.

# 1 Donations

Donations are recognized in the period for which the irrevocable pledge has been made by the donor. Donations-in-kind are recognized as expenses on one hand and donation income on the other hand.

#### 2 Specific Programme Funds

The programme funds are funded by donations made to specific programmes to exclusively serve the financing of the respective programme. Up until 2021, in the absence of a deviating agreement, a share of 30% of donations made to restricted programmes was attributed to cover general and administrative expenses of the foundation. As per decision of the Board in 2022, donations made to specific programmes will be attributed to the respective programme fund in full.

## **Current Programmes and Projects**

The Foundation is conducting comprehensive programmes. These programmes currently are "Joven.lat", "Edificatores", "Emprendedores", "Mujeres" and "Natura".

Within these programmes specific projects are being executed to arrive at the respective programme's goal. These individual projects are of temporary nature.

# Programme "Joven.lat"

The internet-based platform "Joven.lat" is bundling a big number of job-platforms offering a wide range of employment, educational and entrepreneurial opportunities to the young generation of Latin America. The platform is promoted through social networks and various radio stations throughout Latin America to reach as many young people as possible.

#### Programme "Edificatores"

From pre-Columbian temples to colonial Baroque churches, Latin America possesses a rich cultural heritage. However, neglect has led to the deterioration and loss of many heritage assets over the last seventy years. What if unemployed youngsters were to learn a craft and restore their local heritage sites?

Our goal is to train vulnerable youngsters in a craft, enabling them to earn a living from day one. Achieve a significant employment rate after graduation. Participate in the restoration and preservation of local heritage sites in Latin America.

#### Programme "Emprendedores"

The biggest challenge graduates face is not having access to the right tools to work. After extensive preparation, our foundation has launched a new, complementary programme: toolsets for graduates. This initiative gives graduates a basic toolset so that they can work and earn a living from day one after the School programme.

## Programme "Natura"

The programme combines the pleasant (the joy of participating in the protection of the fantastic Latin American nature) with the useful (helping the vulnerable populations living there). Indeed, protecting nature on the spot creates training and jobs, this giving perspectives to those that GANYDAR supports.

## Programme "Mujeres"

Projects have been initiated to support local women in producing profitable and quality professional clothing, to give more autonomy through the work of sewing, to deliver two years of vocational training in the sewing and textile trades, and to develop a center in Switzerland that coordinates all programme activities.
